Develop the essential skills and competencies to work as a counselling psychologist specializing in adult populations with a range of psychological health outcomes

The Master of Science in Counselling Psychology program prepares students with in-depth knowledge and professional training to apply psychological theories and models to help adult populations with a range of psychological concerns from trauma and addiction to stress management and performance. License-eligible graduates of the program will have experience in psychological assessment, case formulation, research and evidence-based intervention in the context of adult mental health.

PROFESSIONAL OUTCOMES

Students will be prepared for a variety of careers in adult mental health settings in different environments, i.e., government agencies, healthcare organizations, private practices, and research. Employment growth over the next decade will be driven by a greater demand for services in mental health centers, social service agencies and hospitals, aligned with the United Arab Emirates' national agenda to work towards prevention and better management of mental health at a population level.

COURSE DELIVERY FORMAT

The Master of Science in Counselling Psychology program is delivered face-to-face in English across four weekdays over 4 semesters at Zayed University located in Abu Dhabi. Students must complete two internships within an external organization and be closely supervised by a licensed psychologist. Students must complete the first internship in semester 3 of the program and the second internship placement in the final semester of the program. For each internship, students must complete a total of 300 hours which is equivalent to 9-8 weeks of full-time work. Therefore, if students are employed at the time of application, their employers must complete the Employer Internship Consent form thereby consenting the employees to release them from their regular employment setting to complete the two internship placements with an external organization..

ADMISSION

- Admission is open to males and females of all nationalities.
- Applicants must have an earned baccalaureate degree in psychology from an accredited university recognized by the UAE Ministry of Education with a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 3.0 (or 2.5 for conditional admission) or higher on a 4.0 point scale or equivalent.
- English language proficiency:
 - A TOEFL score of 213 CBT, 79 iBT (or 197 CBT, 71 iBT for conditional admission), or
 - An IELTS (Academic) overall band score of not less than 6.0 (or 5.5 for conditional admission), or
 - 1400 on the EmSAT English examination (or 1250 for conditional admission), or
 - Evidence that the applicant is a native speaker of English who has completed his/her undergraduate education in an English medium institution in a country where English is the official language.
- Applicant Consent form.
- Employer Internship Consent form.
- Police Clearance Certificate.
- An interview.
